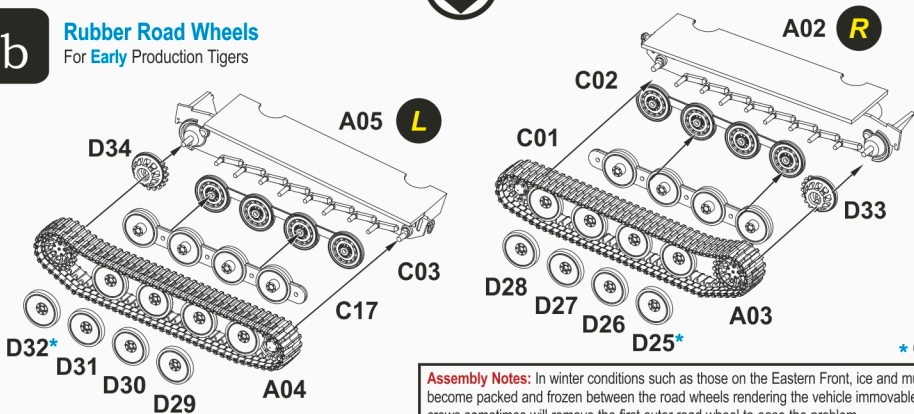

Rubber Road Wheels

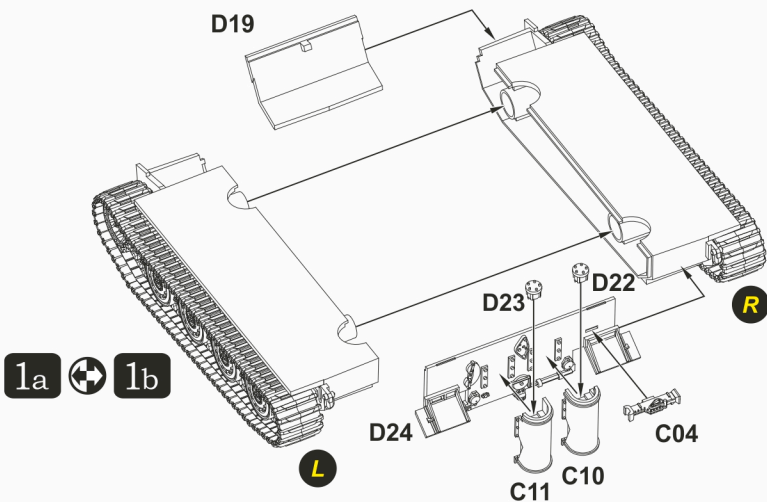

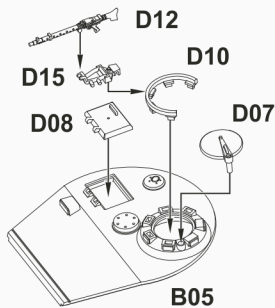

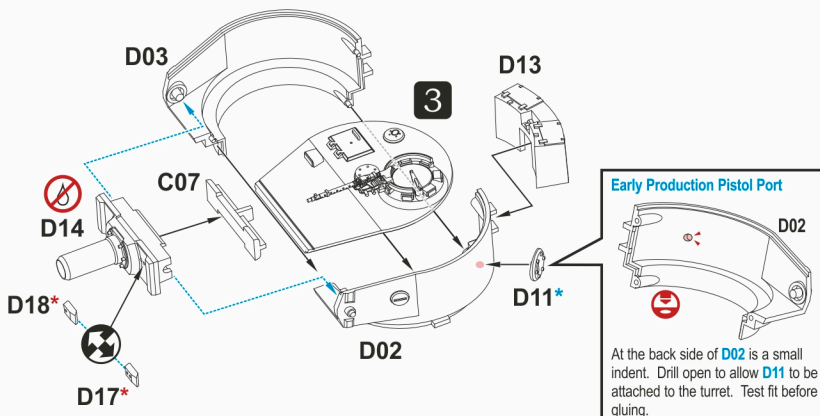

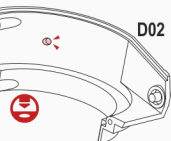

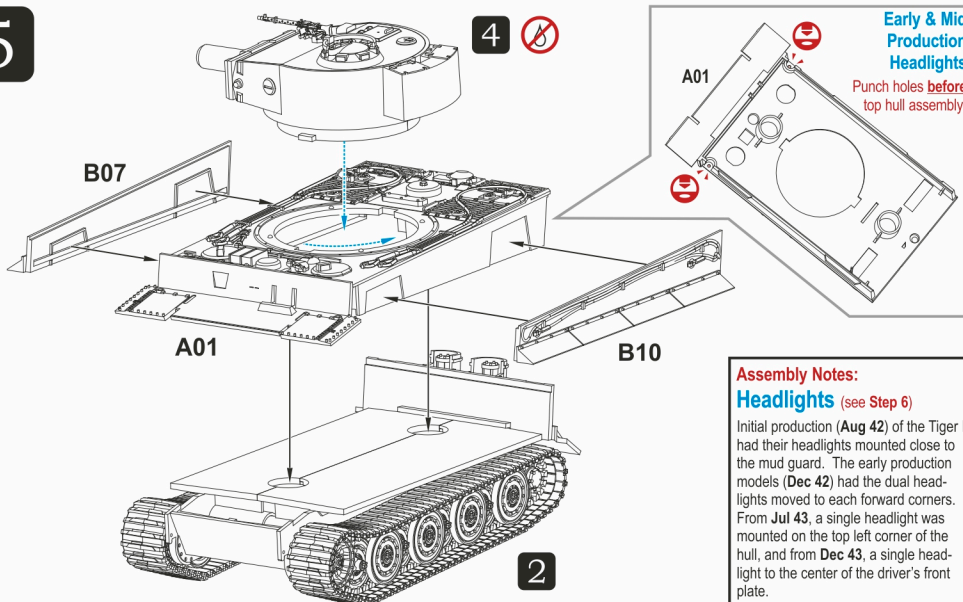

Punch holes before top hull assembly!

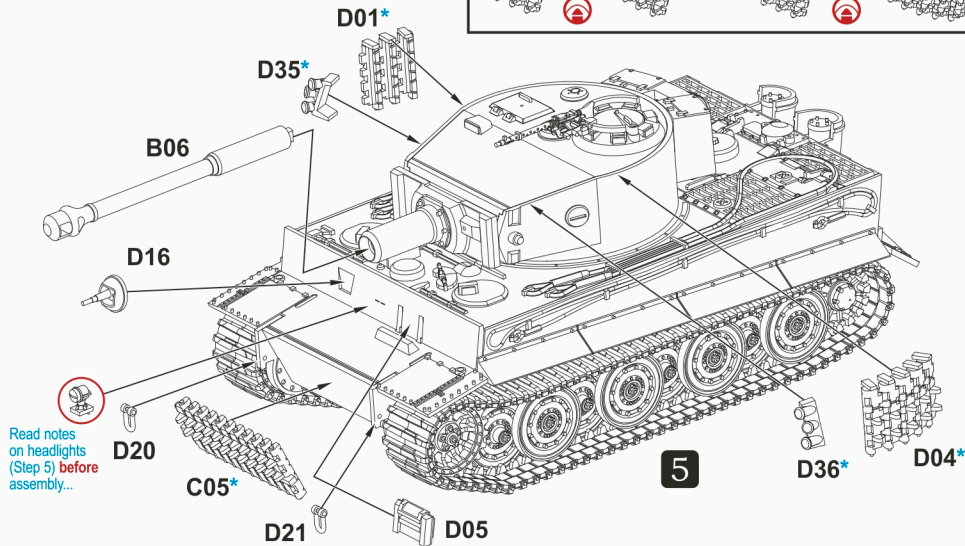
Assembly Notes:

Headlights (see Step 6)

Initial production (Aug 42) of the Tiger I had their headlights mounted close to the mud guard. The early production models (Dec 42) had the dual headlights moved to each forward corners. From Jul 43, a single headlight was mounted on the top left corner of the hull, and from Dec 43, a single headlight to the center of the driver's front plate.

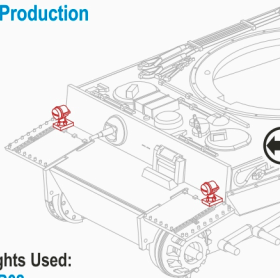
Optional Spare Tracks - Slightly bend the tracks into a curve and fit them onto the turret.

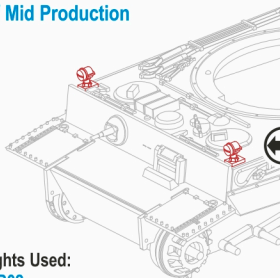

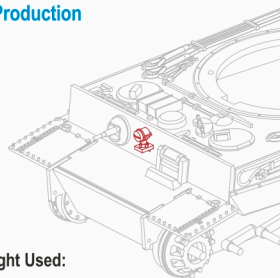

Assembly Notes: Feifel Filters

From Nov 42, for Tigers sent to regions like Tunisia, Sicily, Italy, Heeresgruppe Süd and Mitte in Russia, Feifel air pre-cleaners were installed.

After Aug 43, these were no longer fitted at the factory.
