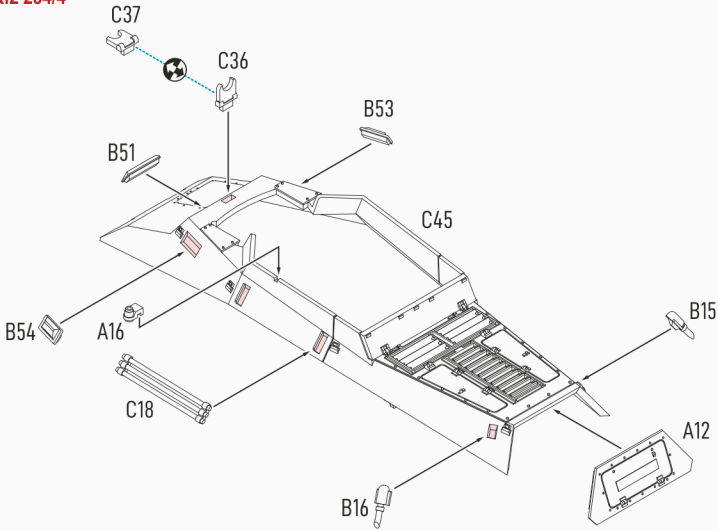
Top View Position Reference

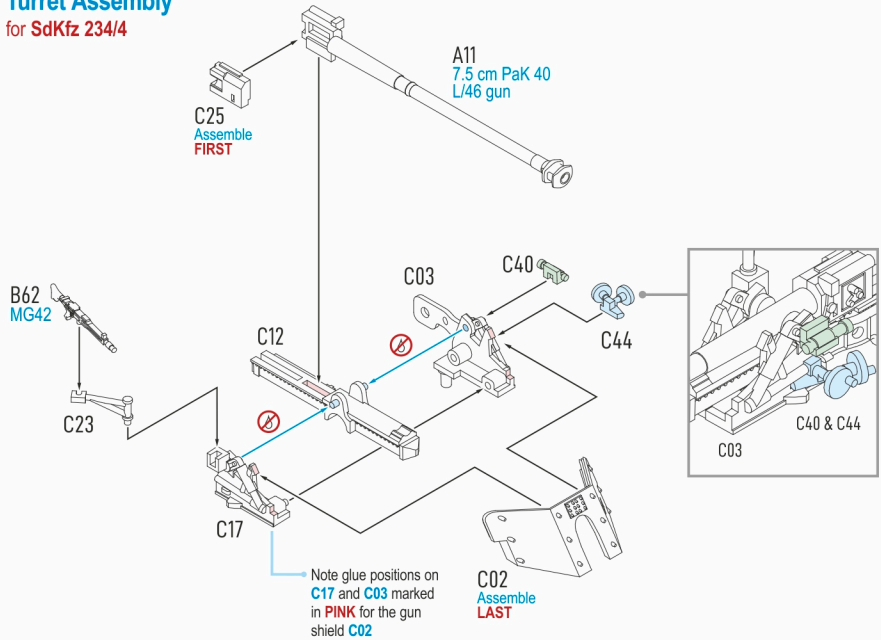

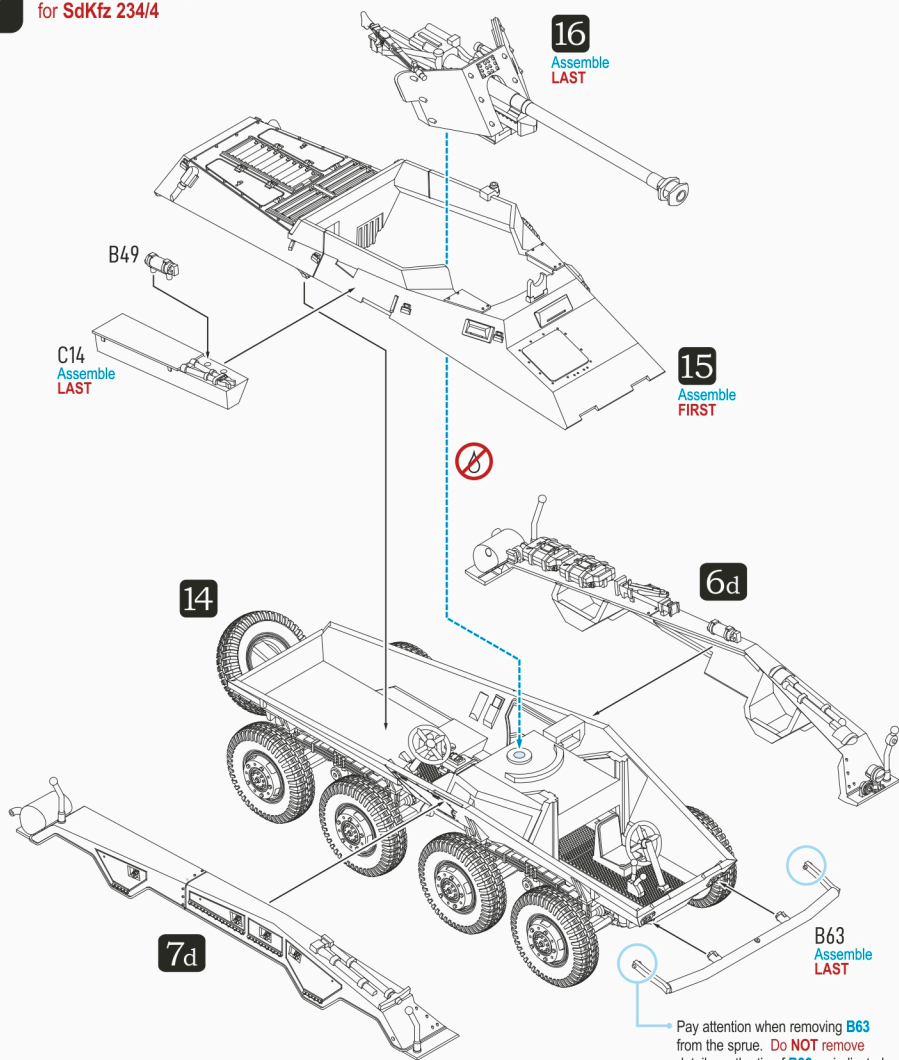

The **SdKfz 234** (Sonderkraftfahrzeug 234, Special Purpose Vehicle 234), was a family of armoured cars designed and built in Germany during World War II. The vehicles were lightly armoured, armed with a 20, 50 or 75mm main gun, and powered by a Tatra V12 diesel engine. There were **four main variants**:

- 234/1** Equipped with a 2cm KwK 38 L/55 autocannon, one 7.92mm MG42 machine gun. This design featured an open-topped turret. Around **200** were produced.
- 234/2** Equipped with a 5cm KwK 39 L/60 gun, one MG42. Employed a fully enclosed turret originally designed for the VK1602 Leopard light tank. The turret front was protected by 30mm (1.2") armour at an angle of 20° from the vertical. The sides and rear had 10mm armour set at 25°, and the top plate was 10mm (0.39") armour. The gun mantlet was rounded and was 40mm to 100mm (1.6" to 3.9") thick. **101** built between September 1943 and September 1944.
- 234/3** Equipped with a 7.5cm K51 L/24 gun in open-topped superstructure replacing the turret. **88** built between June and December 1944.
- 234/4** Equipped with a 7.5cm PaK 40 L/46 gun in open-topped superstructure replacing the turret. **89** built between December 1944 and March 1945.
